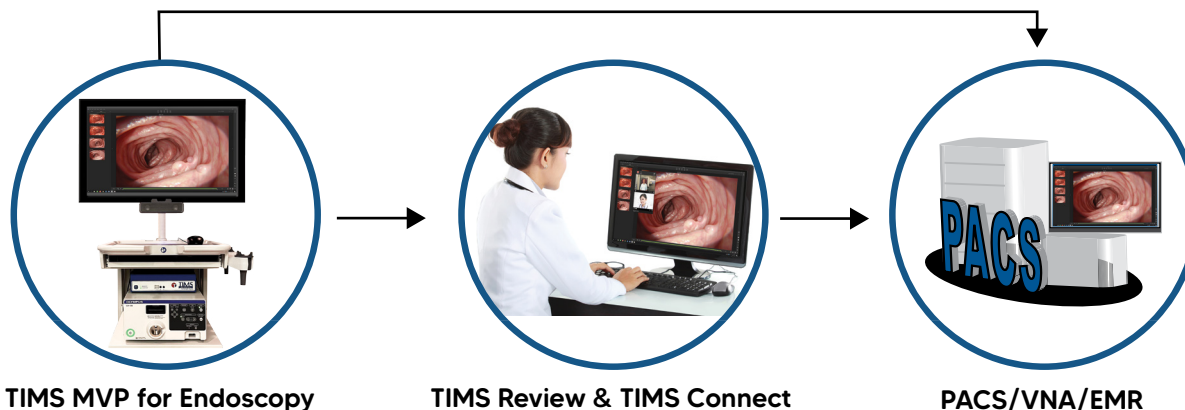

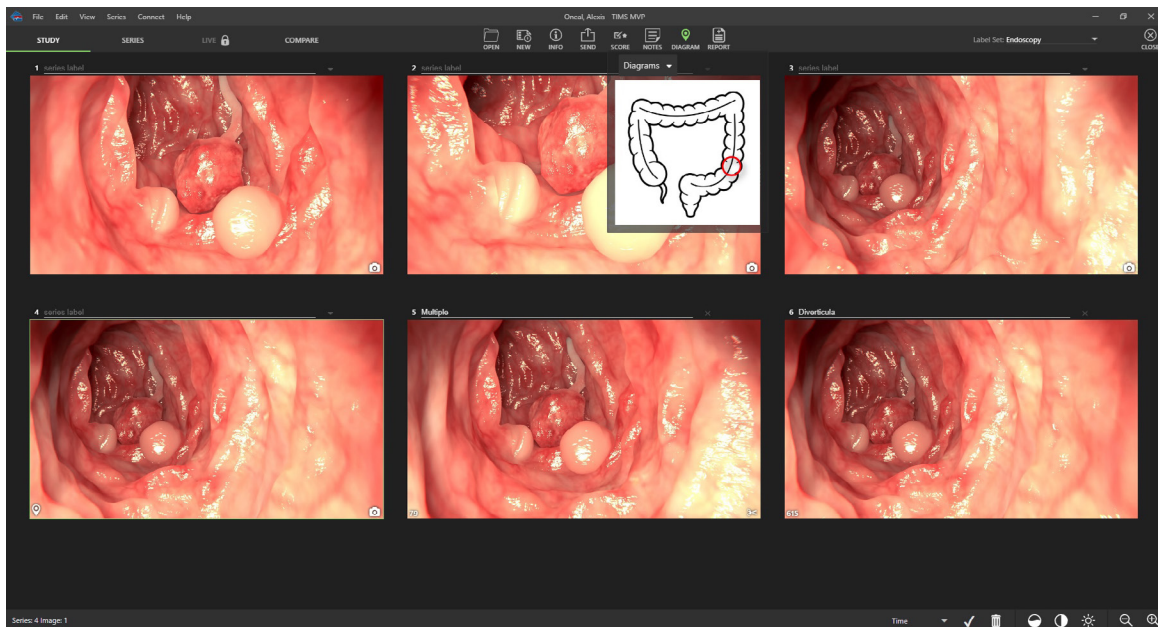

TIMS MVP for Endoscopy Workflow with TIMS Review

After the study is performed, it can be sent directly to PACS. For a more productive workflow, the study can be sent to the TIMS Review software in the endoscopy reporting room for review, editing, annotating, scoring, and reporting. The study is then sent to PACS for availability in the EMR.



TIMS MVP, TIMS Review, & TIMS Connect Workflow



TIMS Review, the Hub of Endoscopy Study Productivity: One license of TIMS Review software is included with every TIMS system and is typically installed in the endoscopy reporting room. After the study is performed, it is sent to TIMS Review, freeing up the endoscopy system for the next patient. Completed studies can be reviewed, edited, labeled, scored, and reported on. This very productive workflow allows for more studies to be performed each day.

TIMS Connect: Included free for one year, TIMS Connect transmits the live procedure from wherever the endoscopy study is performed to a TIMS Review system on the hospital network. Applications include training, supervision, and interactive collaboration between clinicians on patient care during the live procedure. TIMS Connect can be licensed as a yearly subscription after the first year.

TIMS PatientView: Included free for one year, TIMS PatientView allows you to optionally add a picture-in-picture video inset of the procedure room from a USB camera as part of the endoscopy study. TIMS PatientView can be licensed as a yearly subscription after the first year.
